Visa Application Process Overview

- Do you need a visa?
 - a. https://ircc.canada.ca/english/visit/visas.asp
- 2. Request Letter of Invitation from International ACAC
 - a. https://www.internationalacac.org/conference
- 3. Apply for your visitor visa through IRCC Portal
 - a. Don't forget to include the Special Event Code included on your visa letter from International ACAC!
- 4. Complete your biometrics if required
- 5. Upon notice of approval, submit your passport to the nearest Visa Application Center (VAC) by post or carrier



Visa Invitation Letter

- Confirms the purpose of your travel
- Contains the Special Event Code connected to the conference
- Your name is included on a list of visa applicants shared with the IRCC
- Scholars' visa letter includes information about the expenses covered by International ACAC

Applying for a visa can be a cultural experience.

- Do I understand the process processing times, scammers etc.
- Are there inconsistencies in my application?
 e.g.Travel time vrs flight booking
- Have I demonstrated enough ties family, work etc.
- Have I stated the purpose of my visit clearly with no ambiguity
- Have I prepared for the interview if there's one?
- Will I give myself a visa if I was the counselor officer?
