I have attended numerous International ACAC conferences as an attendee. I have presented once, and also been on pre-conference faculty once (2023).

There are so many points that could, and should, be emphasized, but it is important to create goals that are attainable, or at least great strides can be made in achieving them. Personally, I think producing a comprehensive resource of majors offered, and scholarship possibilities is really needed. I know...there are an abundance of websites but frankly they fall out of date quickly and the vendors are always trying to upsell you to get your information seen. There must be a better way. I also think creating an awareness of how UG majors lead to specific careers or graduate degrees is needed. The challenge is HOW to get the information out and then getting people to see it. I think there are great professional development opportunities for our secondary school counselors. What about a series of leadership/university prep day-long workshops for students that are offered in cities around the world. They need to be interactive and low-cost. U.S. reps could present, and it could even culminate with a college fair.

I have been a board member of the Michigan Association of International Educators for almost 30 years. I present annually on admissions trends, hot topics, and a workshop for international recruitment beginners. I have been a member of NAFSA for the same amount of time, and I have held numerous leadership positions at the regional and national level including: NAFSA Region CV - IEM Chair, and Regional Chair; and NAFSA IEM Chair, Member Engagement Committee member. I have also served on public and private school boards for 15 years. I currently serve on our local educational foundation board.

I have been fortunate to have held numerous leadership positions, both in and outside of education. One challenge is making sure people understand the benefits of membership, beyond conference attendance, which then involved even more expenditure.

Outside of higher ed, I was named to the Allendale (Michigan) Public Schools Hall of Fame for significant contributions to the school district. It is the only award given to an non-alum of the district.
