Discuss your involvement with International ACAC, highlighting specific roles (with dates) and contributions made during your volunteer or leadership tenure. I volunteered in the First Timers' committee for the conference of 2023 in Miami and supported the planning for the events of first timers. It was my first time volunteering for International ACAC but I think it changed my mindset on how much I could be engaged in organizations like IACAC and how much difference I can make for the counselors and admissions community. I joined almost every meeting during my volunteering for First Timers and paired with a group of around 20 first timer buddies and supported the first timer's activity in Miami. I was committed to my role last year and took the initiative of reaching out to a volunteer in Africa who were in the first buddy's group by setting up meetings with him and communicated how we could better support them.

Firstly, I want to make my best effort to elevate the collaboration of counselors community regionally. I have an understanding of the collaboration of counselors' collaboration regionally/by country. However, I do see the need and the force of following the trend of elevating collaboration into a deeper level to work together on connecting, sharing, and supporting each other to have our voice heard, and advocate for DEI, and our students in the region. Having worked in Beijing, Shanghai, Shenzhen and in different types of schools including public schools international department in Beijing, bilingual school in Shenzhen, and international school in Shanghai, I am confident to really understand the context when working with different types of schools in terms of the culture and dynamic. Secondly, I want to support more on empowering international students to transit well in college/university and support their long-term growth and success since high school, or even middle school. In my counseling career of more than 10 years, I did have former students who struggled different issues in their undergraduate studies in US like mental health issues, time management, lacking of academic support etc. that led to intense and severe consequences that they couldn't graduate or had to drop out of college or transit and seeking other programs to pursue and compete their Bachelor's degree. I had involved in designing a Leadership program and recruited 20 admissions and college counselors the tools to empower the minority group of students in these issues, and to help them identify their culture capitals when exposed in a diverse culture.

I have co-led a leadership program and recruited 20 admissions and college counselors talking about DEI, how to support the underprivileged students and minorities and empower them the abilities and skills to identify their culture capitals and support their long-term success when studying abroad. I have also led a "Speaker Series" program and had ran 4 talks by inviting the most popular sessions in conferences like IACAC to talk about the session they made or more critical topics like collaboration in counselors' community to enable free access to the counselors who were unable to attend the conferences physically to learn about the most up to date sessions, and also to extend the discussions of those topics in counselors community and their daily work. I have initiated and built the counselors' network event in Great Bay Area in China and been putting efforts to promote the regional collaboration of counselors' community.

I'm applying to the representative of Executive Board because I want to work together with colleagues who have the same passion to raise the voice for DEI, to collaborate together and make bigger impact in the whole industry. I want to be sensitive and alerted on issues we can work on and have the platform to make real changes. I never hesitate to speak up when I feel like I need to. I have learnt the way how people are collaborating together during my volunteering experiences of last year in first timers' committee. I'm looking forward to pushing the trend of collaboration in different regions and create valuable resources in supporting the underprivileged students or even coworkers. I want to support the executive board the vision of the organization as much as possible.

inspired by their growth and creativity. I want to be someone like that. And I am determined to stand firmly in this side and at the same time to be critical and open about new ideas and include more different voices to be raised.
