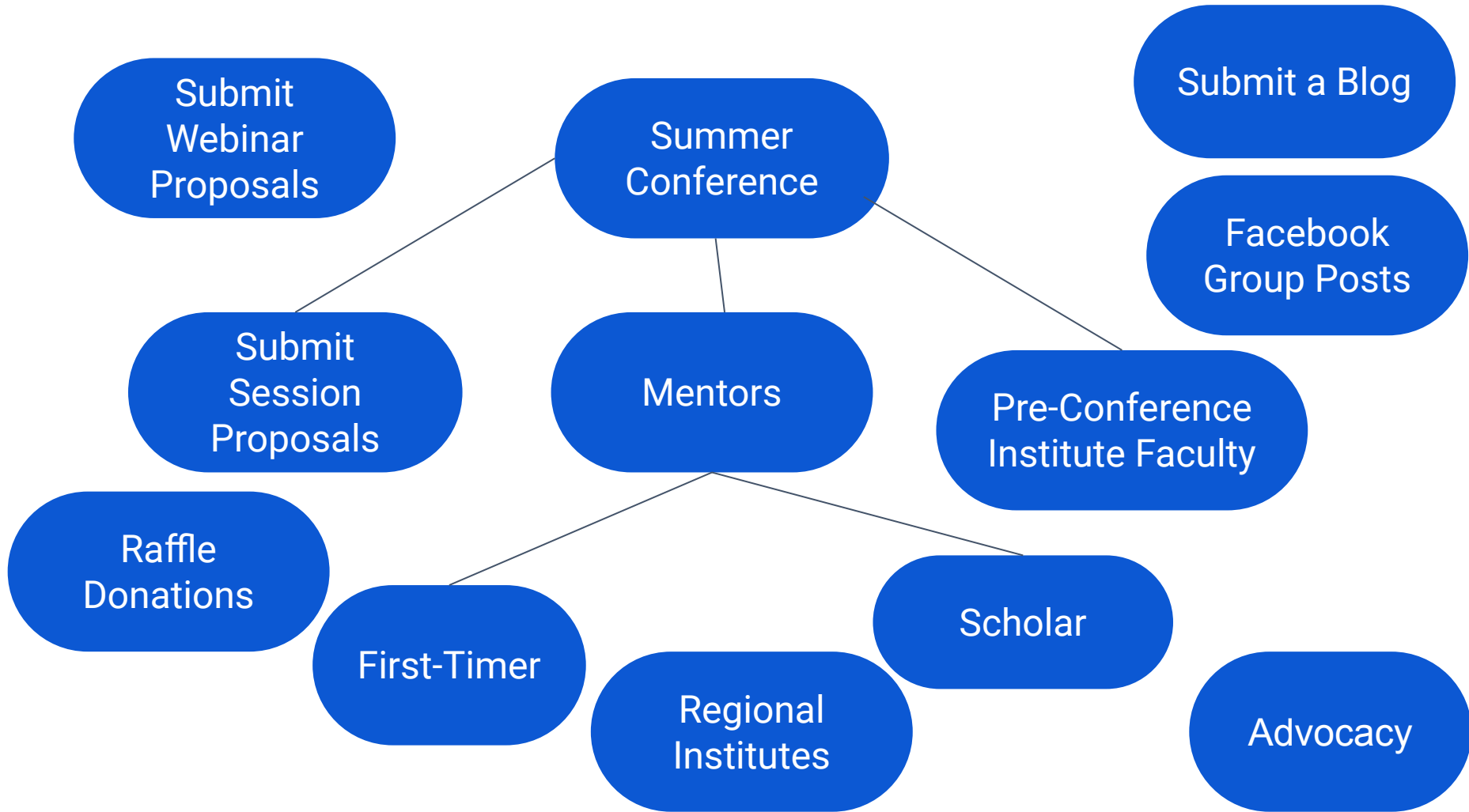

 - designed and developed the website
 - dedicated untold hours to make this organization work
- **Today**, International ACAC has three full-time staff members plus a consultant supporting Regional Institutes.
 - However, most activities continue to be run by volunteers.

5. **Highlight diversity** - What do you offer?
6. **Follow advice you give to students**
